

Are You Ready and Willing to Serve?

If God is nudging you to serve in ways that affirm the connectional nature of the Presbyterian denomination --- below are thumbnail descriptions of the purpose of teams and committees, each requesting three-year terms. Please fill out Nomination Form if interested.

Peace River Presbytery Committees and Teams:

Committee on Ministry: 21 members --- Responsible for the nurture, care and development of positive relationships among: Ministers of the Word and Sacrament, educators, congregations, and Presbytery. Meets 2nd Tuesday of each month at the Presbytery office.

Committee on Preparation for Ministry (CPM): 6 members --- Provides care and supervision of all Inquirers and Candidates, carrying out all responsibilities detailed in the Book of Order plus supervision of education for Ruling Elders preparing for commissioned Pastoral Service. Meets about 6 times a year; mostly at the Presbytery office.

Communication, Connection and Community Team: 9 members --- Oversee the development of a communications strategy that enhances connections across the Presbytery and nurtures a community of sharing and learning; includes planning of stated Presbytery meetings. Ordinarily meets monthly, some at Presbytery office, some via video-conferencing.

Finance Team/Trustees: 9 members --- Support the Presbytery and its congregations in their discipleship mission of bringing people to Christ by providing financial and asset management counseling as well as hands on assistance when requested. Meets the second Thursday of the month at Presbytery office.

Human Resources Team: 9 members --- Provides leadership on matters related to the faithful deployment of God's people in Peace River Presbytery to include paid staff, volunteer staff and volunteers. Take a broad view of task analysis, performance appraisals and leadership development. Ordinarily meeting monthly, usually 2nd Wednesday of the month, some at Presbytery office, some via video-conferencing.

Mision Peniel Team: 9 members --- Serve as a Christ-centered and compassionate bridge connecting migrant farm workers in Immokalee Florida to faith communities and the world. Meets on the first Thursday of each month at 10:00 a.m. at Misi3n Peniel in Immokalee.

Outreach and Nurture Team: 9 members --- Support congregations in their work to reach out to the greater world through grace-filled generosity through support of covenant partners and other mission initiatives. Assess opportunities for new worshipping communities. Oversee award process for Blessing Grants. Ordinarily meets monthly, some at Presbytery office, some via video-conferencing.
